Meeting Summary – May 22, 1998

Introduction

The meeting was called to order by Chair Dick Nichols.

I. Intergovernmental Agreement

Chairman Nichols provided a status on the Chehalis Basin Partnership intergovernmental agreement. He expressed some concern about how long it can take to reach final approval. Some changes are proposed for Section 11 – Termination. Agreement was reached to provide the Quinault Indian Nation additional time to review the document before finalizing. Chairman Nichols asked Brian Walsh to stay in contact with the tribe regarding amendments to the document. (With the understanding that any substantive changes would come before the group for discussion.) A letter from the Chehalis River Council regarding citizen participation on the Chehalis Basin Partnership is also unresolved. Chairman Nichols indicated he plans to meet with Dave Palmer from the group to discuss this further. Once these matters get resolved, Elizabeth Petrich of the Thurston County Prosecutor's Office will be available prepare a final draft for approval by the group. Chairman Nichols emphasized the need for the group to formally exist via the agreement.
